Teacher of Modern Foreign Languages – French and Spanish

Thank you for your interest in this post. We are currently hoping to recruit an outstanding teacher of languages to join the MFL Department.

The High School Leckhampton opened to Year 7 in September 2021 on our temporary site at Balcarras School. In September 2022 we moved to our £30 million, state-of-the-art building at Farm Lane, Leckhampton where we welcomed a new cohort of Year 7 pupils. The school has expanded each year, and we will take a new cohort of 180 pupils into Year 7 annually, until it reaches a capacity of 900 pupils. From September 2025, we will have 750 pupils on roll in years 7-11, as follows:

Year 7 = 180 pupils
Year 8 = 180 pupils
Year 9 = 150 pupils
Year 10 = 120 pupils
Year 11 = 120 pupils

We are on a very exciting journey!

The High School Leckhampton is part of The Balcarras Multi Academy Trust, and we already work closely with Balcarras School. During our first year we were temporarily housed in a brand-new building on the site of Balcarras and shared several teachers and this close relationship has continued in year 4. Consequently, all applicants should look at the Balcarras Trust website for additional information about the ethos and culture of The Trust. Winchcombe School joined The Trust in November 2023 and subject networks are in place across all 3 schools.

At this time, we are looking to recruit a superb teacher of French and Spanish, who will join our school. This is an exciting opportunity to work alongside our existing language teachers – Dr P Clarke, Ms L Claydon and Mrs L Wright, as we take our first cohort of Year 11 GCSE pupils into their exams in summer 2026. We are looking for an

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inspirational teacher and are prepared to consider both experienced and Early Career Teachers. All candidates should have an excellent track record of achieving, or the potential to achieve, outstanding GCSE outcomes. The successful candidate should be capable of teaching French to at least GCSE and Spanish to at least KS3 (but ideally GCSE).

One of our school values is to 'expand horizons,' and we see the provision of modern languages as being central to this, not least by encouraging our pupils to understand different countries and cultures whilst becoming proficient foreign language speakers themselves. We hope that our pupils will see the value of learning new languages and therefore develop into open minded, empathetic young people, eager to understand and explore the world around them.

At The High School Leckhampton we believe in developing the whole child and as such extra-curricular clubs and super curricular activities already play a key part of the life of the school and the person appointed will, we hope, make a strong contribution to them. The successful candidate will seek to provide our pupils with enriching opportunities, such as languages clubs and participation in international trips. Above all else, we are looking for a dedicated, enthusiastic, and highly skilled MFL teacher who will integrate smoothly into the existing team and who shares our values.

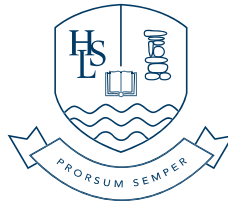

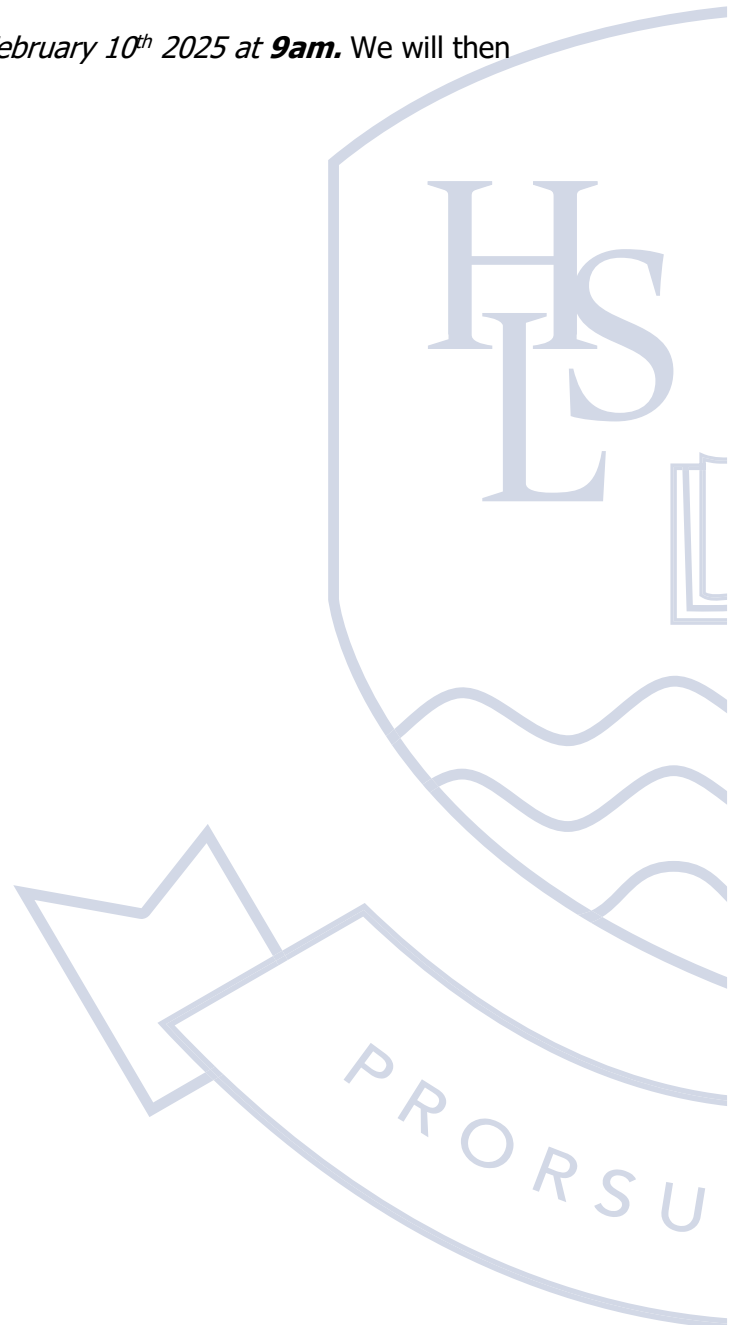

GENERAL INFORMATION

Applications are invited for the position of **Teacher of Modern Foreign Languages** at The High School Leckhampton, from September 2025.

We are seeking a dynamic, forward-thinking teacher of MFL to help develop the department as we move into our 5th year and welcome a new cohort of Year 7 pupils from September 2025. This is a tremendously exciting opportunity, and the successful applicant will have the opportunity to significantly shape the experiences of our students in MFL as they progress through our growing school.

We see it as of paramount importance to appoint the right person to join a very successful and happy teaching staff that is already notable for its particularly strong emphasis on teamwork and mutual support. The Curriculum

Our Year 7 pupils learn French and in Year 8 all pupils also study Spanish. All pupils continue to study both languages in Year 9. It is our aspiration that the vast majority of our

pupils will choose to study a language at GCSE. We currently have 2 classes of French and 2 classes of Spanish in Year 10. The successful applicant should therefore be able to demonstrate the ability to teach French and Spanish and be a highly effective classroom practitioner.

The appointed candidate will be expected to plan and deliver a curriculum that is both challenging and inclusive, so should be able to teach to pupils of all abilities. The successful candidate will play a vital role in delivering high standards of education and ensuring students are fully involved in the wider life of the school.

Already our pupils have enjoyed extra-curricular languages clubs including Mandarin, French, Latin, Italian and British Sign Language. The appointed candidate should be excited by the opportunity of either continuing these clubs or exploring new opportunities. We are currently offering a foreign residential to Spain in October 2025.
